# GOSPEL ACCORDING TO SAINT JOHN: JN 20:19-23.

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

## LET US DEEPEN THE TEXT.

To transmit the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to his <u>disciples</u>, Jesus breathes on them. This makes us think of the famous phrase from the book <u>Genesis</u>, chapter 2: "The Lord God breathes into the nostrils of man the vital breath and man is constituted as a living being" (Gn 2:7). And Psalm 103 (which we read on the Feast of Pentecost), comments on the text of Creation singing: "You send your breath, and they are created." And it is precisely on Easter evening when Jesus takes up this creative gesture. It is understood why Saint John insists: "On the evening of that first day of the week," which is a way of saying that it is the first day of the new creation.

Second element to highlight about the breath. It could be said that the order chosen by John to tell us about <u>Pentecost</u> is a lesson: let us return to the three phrases in order of appearance: 1) "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." 2) And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. 3) If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven."

The first and third sentences say a mission. Between the two is framed the phrase that speaks of the gift of the Spirit. This clearly says that the Spirit is given FOR the mission. This mission is our only reason for being.

Mission that consists of "forgiving sins" and that was also the mission of Jesus. And He says it very clearly: "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." Hearing this, they feel like getting to work quickly!

Furthermore, God's forgiveness can be announced in two ways: through our words and through our gestures. This is what is

asked of us: that we be, ourselves, forgiveness. From here we are, for the world, witnesses of God's forgiveness.

And this is the new Creation: the Spirit of the gift of forgiveness is given to us. At <u>Pentecost</u>, the power to forgive is breathed within us.

#### CLUES FOR THE PRAYER.

- Sometimes our doors are closed, those of our community, home...
  what doors do I have closed out of fear? What fears invade me?
- What does Jesus offer us in our experiences of fear? What does He offer to the apostles?
- Jesus trusts us, He sends us. What does Jesus send you to?
