GOSPEL - John 3, 16 - 18,

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. Because God did not send his Son into the world, to judge the world but so that the world might be saved through him. He who believes in him is not judged; but he who does not believe is already judged, because he has not believed in the Name of the only Son of God."

We deepen the gospel

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son"; here is expressed the great passage from the Old Testament to the New Testament. God loves the world, that is, humanity: it was already known in the Old Testament. It was even the great discovery of the people of Israel. The great novelty of the New Testament is therefore the gift of the Son for the salvation of all human beings.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son": thus, everyone who believes in him will not perish, but will obtain eternal life". Well understood, it is enough to believe in Him to obtain salvation. There is the good news of the gospel and, in particular, in the gospel of John. And when he says "eternal life", John evokes something other than biological life; John speaks of that dimension of life that is the life of the Spirit in us, that life that is infused into us on the day of our baptism. (John 5, 24; 11, 26) for John, that is salvation. In a biblical sense, to be saved is to live in peace with oneself and with others; it is to live as a brother to human beings and as a child of God. To get there, it is enough, Jesus tells us, to turn towards Him and thus live permanently inspired by his spirit that infuses us with the behaviour of brothers and children.

To be saved, the only thing that is required of us is to believe in God who saves, and to believe in God who liberates in order to be liberated. It is enough for us, then, to look at Jesus with a look of faith to be saved.

Chouraqui translates this word "believe" as "adhere": it is not therefore an opinion; believing, in Saint John, has a very strong

sense; Adhering to Jesus is like being grafted onto Him, inseparable from Him.

Here we find, once again, Saint Paul; God's project is that all of humanity be reunited in Jesus and live his life, which consists in entering into communion of love with the Trinity. That is what he calls salvation or eternal life. And this is the meaning of the expression "to escape from judgment", that is, from separation: It is enough for us to believe in the mercy of God to be able to enter into it.

Clues for prayer

- How does today's celebration help you to deepen the mystery of God?
- Does being baptized help you understand your mission as a Christian in this world and continue to bring the gospel to every creature?
- What are the gifts that God has given you and lead you to commit yourself to your community and to the society?
