GOSPEL – Luke 24, 35-48

"They, for their part, told what had happened on the way and how they had met him at the breaking of bread. They were talking about these things, when he stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." Startled and frightened, they thought they saw a spirit. But he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet; I'm myself. Feel me and see that a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have. And saying this, he showed them his hands and his feet. As they could not quite believe it because of their joy and were astonished, he said to them: "Do you have anything to eat here?" They offered him part of a roast fish. He took it and ate before them. Then he said to them: "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you: 'Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, in the Prophets, and in the Psalms." And then, he opened their minds so that they could understand the Scriptures, and he said to them: "Thus it is written that the Christ suffered and rose from the dead on the third day and that conversion for the forgiveness of sins would be preached in his name to all nations.", starting from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

To deepen the text: (Marie-Noëlle THABUT)

Chapter 3 of the Acts of the Apostles sets before us the context in which Peter speaks; It is what would be called a true plea; According to him, it is about making his interlocutors go through a capital stage in the Faith; Everyone shares the same Faith in the God of the Fathers, everyone waits for the Messiah, everyone knows the prophecies of the Old Testament, but how can we convince them that those prophecies concerned Jesus Christ? Ultimately, Peter is trying to open the eyes of the Jews to what can be called "a miscarriage of justice."

Psalm 4 is short, it has nine verses, but it is enriched with all the faith of Israel, with all that long history of the Covenant between

the chosen people and their God, for centuries. "The Lord hears when I cry out to him" (verse 4).

Juan, in his letter, develops three convictions. First, we are all sinners: even if sin is not our usual topic of conversation, we know perfectly well that "no one is perfect." But, here comes the second conviction, the great news of the Bible, it is not that we are sinners, but that we are forgiven; Jesus' announcement, to all those he meets in the Gospels, is "your sins are forgiven." Finally, the third conviction, expressed by John in today's text, is that in Jesus we are all forgiven: «If one of us sins, we have a defender before the Father; Jesus Christ, the Just.

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Tips for prayer

- Death and resurrection, wounds and scars, sin and forgiveness, what does this gospel text tell us about it?
- How do you live these realities in your life?

- In our world, in the Church, in your community, how do we live and accept these realities?
