\* **DANCE OF LIFE** as a Psalm of Hope. (Founders and First Sisters).

Candles, ribbons, bouquets, water are prepared, or simply with the hands, feet, body, free movements are made, in prayer, gestures that express love, gratitude, praise... for the life given and passed on for the Charity of our Founders and First Sisters.
