GOSPEL- Luke 24, 46-53

"At that time Jesus said to his disciples: Thus, it was written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins would be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. Look, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. For your part, remain in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." He led them out as far as Bethany and, lifting his hands, blessed them. While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up to heaven. They after worshipping him, returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were always in the temple blessing God.

To deepen the Word today (Marie-Noëlle THABUT)

Acts: 1, 1-11. The Lord's departure, taken up to heaven, is the crucial event between the time of Jesus and the time of the Church. Inaugurated by the baptism "in the Holy Spirit" received by the Apostles, this time is the time of the mission "to the ends of the earth."

Psalm 46:2-9. "Blasting of the horn," "fanfare"; the Good News resounds throughout the world until Christ returns.

Hebrews 9:24-28. Jesus enters once and for all into the sanctuary of heaven. All the men he has redeemed are assured of being admitted with him near God, in eternity.

Luke 24:46-53. Having instructed them for forty days, he finally rose above the turmoil of the world. Jesus revealed himself beyond the weight of sin, the sadness, the remorse that oppresses the world. He entered the land of peace and joy, the land of purest light. He entered the abode of the angels, very close to the Father. There he entered. This doesn't mean he

moved from here below, far from it. The Lord is forever in his glory, close to the Father. This is what faith is doing, meditating on the immense benefits this exaltation has bestowed upon the world. Like the Passover of Christ's death and resurrection on the third day, the universal mission of the Church fulfils the Scriptures, because Jesus suffered and was raised from the dead so that they may enjoy life forever. This is the Good News that we who recognize Jesus as Lord must proclaim to the whole world.

- A man, Jesus, sits next to God. What does this mean in your life?

- Jesus ascended to heaven and remains among us. Do you share this experience with him?
- What does the Feast of the Ascension mean in the life of our community, parish, or whatever?
