

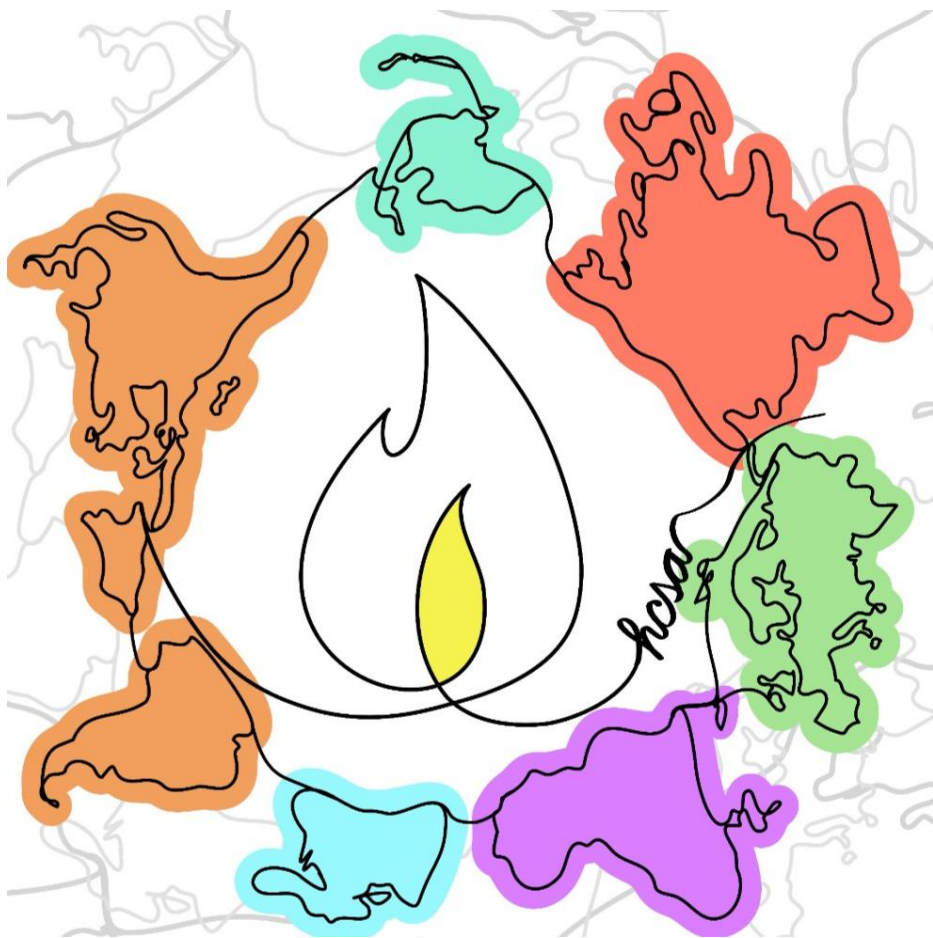

## GOSPEL – Jn 20, 19-23

“On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, when the doors were locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus stood among them and said to them, “Peace be with you.” When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced to see the Lord. “Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the father has sent me, even so I send you.” When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.”

**To deepen the Word today (*Marie-Noëlle THABUT*)**

**Acts 2,1-11.** Thanks to the Spirit given on the day of Pentecost, people throughout the world can benefit from divine election and the wonders God has performed. Furthermore, from now on, everyone can hear the Good News in their own language. Pentecost restores the unity that Babel had shattered.

Psalm 103. Thanksgiving for the good of the Spirit, wisdom, breath of life, strength of what has been renewed.

Thanksgiving for the goodness of the Spirit, wisdom, breath of life, strength of what has been renewed.

**Romans 8:8-17.** With Christ, we are heirs to a new condition of believers, attested by the Spirit. We will be resurrected like Him. And He is the one who grants us to live in the freedom of children of God.

**Jn 20,19-23.** Like the Epiphany at the end of the liturgies, which celebrate the manifestation of the Son of God in our flesh, Pentecost closes the fifty days during which the Church, each year, celebrates the Passover of Christ. These are decisive stages in the history of salvation, which unfolds from the beginning and will culminate in the glorious return of the Lord at the end of time. The Incarnation of God and his Resurrection are closely linked. The Gospels of the two Pentecost Masses, Saturday and Sunday, are taken from Jesus' last interviews with his disciples. At the moment of visibly leaving the earth, Jesus speaks to his disciples about the new condition they find themselves in in the world after his departure. He does not abandon them. He will send them the Spirit, the Advocate, to guide them on the path that will lead them to his own resurrection, close to the Father. Pentecost, therefore, does not commemorate an event of the past. This feast celebrates God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who manifests himself day after day on earth and who will be fully revealed when the Son of Man returns. Pentecost is a daily occurrence for those who, in the name of the Lord Jesus, pray to the Father and ask him to give them the Spirit promised by the Son. Let us give thanks for the faith we have received, which reveals to us the one God who has become one of us and who gives us his wisdom.

- - How can we transmit the Spirit's presence to those around us?
