GOSPEL – John 16, 12-15

""I still have much to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. When he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. For he will not speak on his own, but what he hears, he will speak; and he will declare to you what is to come. He will glorify me because he will take what is mine and declare it to you. All that the Father has is mine. Therefore, I said, 'He will take what is mine and declare it to you."

To deepen the Word today (Marie-Noëlle THABUT)

Prov. 8, 22-31.

To evoke the inexpressible transcendence of divine wisdom, the author of the Book of Proverbs personalizes this attribute, without denying strict biblical monotheism. It can be applied to a very specific and concrete person to whom it is perfectly suited.

Psalm 8. At the heart of the new creation, in Christ, man rediscovers his divine greatness.

Rom 5:1-5. Salvation is a gift from God obtained not through works but through faith in Christ and thanks to the presence of the Spirit within us. The intervention of the divine Persons in what is called "the economy of salvation" is explicitly stated here: everything comes from the Father, through the Son, in the Spirit; it is the proof of God's love in the human heart.

Jn 16,11-15. Here Jesus reveals the intimacy of the Trinity, a mystery into which he himself introduces us. But to perceive this mystery of love and communion, we must agree with him; it is essential that we ourselves be a blazing fire of love and communion. What Jesus tells us in this Gospel, among other things, is that the Spirit of God, his fire, will come to us and dwell within us. We must keep in mind that we are still in the context of

the Last Supper on Holy Thursday: Jesus bids farewell to his disciples and prepares them for the events to come. He reveals almost all of his mystery to them, but there are things they cannot yet understand: "I would have much more to tell you, but for now, you do not have the strength to bear it." The history of humanity, like all human history, is the history of a long journey. Here Jesus reveals the intimacy of the Trinity, a mystery into which he himself introduces us.
