The volunteers participated in a practical exercise, navigating the various official websites that contain the information explained in the morning: consulates, visa requirements, necessary vaccinations, safety recommendations, and other key resources. This session allowed them to resolve specific questions and provided participants with practical tools for their upcoming mission.

The meeting concluded in an atmosphere of gratitude and shared joy. It was, without a doubt, a very enriching day, combining formation, personal experiences, and camaraderie. The participants returned home very happy, with their hearts full of motivation and a renewed desire to continue walking together in service to others, faithful to the spirit of the Saint Anne Volunteering Program.
